9 SEEDING	Seeding will be according to the latest available World Ranking.
10 CANCELLATION	Cancellation deadline Cancellation of participation is possible till 14 July 2021 at 18h local time Cancellation must be sent to the competition manager of the event and to the local organiser at the same time! After this deadline, the penalty for non show policy will apply and a cancellation fee of 100 US\$ will be charged for each athlete. Note: <i>The penalty fee can be waived if a medical certificate is submitted, and the player does not compete in other events during the event.</i> IMPORTANT Players will not be allowed to enter future FITEQ events if any cancellation fees remain outstanding.
11 REPLACEMENT POLICY	Replacements Pairs can be replaced by another athlete from the any country until the cancellation deadline. The organisation and travel costs of the new athlete must be paid by the team, as well as any administrative fees FITEQ incurs for the change of reservations.
