17 ACCREDITATION

19 VISA

Visas should be arranged and obtained by the athletes, coaches, team officials in their own country. Please check the visa requirements for entry to the country before booking your travel and allow time for the visa application process. Upon request, invitation letter to be provided by LOC. All costs incurred are worn by the participants.

20 INSURANCE

By entering the event, each team must ensure that all delegation members have medical, travel and other appropriate insurance. All costs incurred are worn by the participants.

21 INFORMATION FOR PLAYERS

By entering the event, all athletes and other participants in general agree to accept all FITEQ rules, policies and the rules and regulations of the organising committee. Participants release all rights in all matters relating to television and web casting coverage, video and motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. A participant's refusal of above listed coverage may be subject to suspension or dismissal from the competition.
