

# World Teqball Championships 2023 - Bangkok, Thailand

## Game Zone Area Policy



### 1. General Entry and Usage

1.1 Athletes, coaches, and team officials are permitted to enter the Game Zone Area 10 minutes before their scheduled match. Prior to that, they may utilize the designated warm-up area.

1.2 Main and Assistant Referees, as well as Chief Referees, are also allowed to enter the Game Zone only 10 minutes before the game they are officiating.

### 2. Post-Match Protocol

2.1 Upon completion of their match, players must promptly exit the Field of Play (FOP) and the Game Zone. The designated route for exiting is through the Mixed Zone, and it is important to note that there is only one entrance/exit point for the Game Zone.

2.2 In the Mixed Zone, photographers, videographers, press, and social media teams are allowed to request interviews with players. Players are obligated to respond to inquiries from these authorized personnel.

### 3. Game Zone Access Limits

3.1 Only one coach and two team officials per nation are permitted in the Game Zone during matches.

3.2 The FITEQ Social Media Team as well as accredited press with extra signage are only allowed in the Game Zone during the event.

3.3 FITEQ STAFF are always allowed to use the Game Zone Area.

### 4. Exceptional Access

4.1 During matches, the Press Officer, Chief Referees, and Competition Managers have the authority to consider requests for access to the Game Zone by athletes or press. Such requests will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis with due consideration for the overall event regulations.

### 5. Compliance and Enforcement

5.1 Athletes, coaches, team officials, referees, and staff are expected to adhere to the Game Zone Area Policy at all times.

5.2 Failure to comply with the policy may result in penalties, including fines or disqualification, as determined by the event organizers.

5.3 The Press Officer, Chief Referees, and Competition Managers will actively enforce the policy during the World Teqball Championships 2023.

### 6. Amendments to the Policy

6.1 The World Teqball Championships organizers reserve the right to amend or update the Game Zone Area Policy as needed. Any changes will be communicated to all relevant parties in a timely manner.

This policy is designed to ensure the smooth operation of the Game Zone Area during the World Teqball Championships and to provide a structured environment for athletes, coaches, and media personnel. All participants are expected to respect and adhere to these guidelines for the successful execution of the event.
