

Qualification System for Romania for the World Teqball Championships 2024

QUALIFICATION CATEGORIES ON THE QUALIFICATION COMPETITIONS:

- Men's Singles
- Women's Singles
- Men's Doubles
- Women's Doubles
- Mixed Doubles

COMPETITION ROUNDS:

- Total Rounds: 2 rounds (5 categories in each round)

POINT SYSTEM:

The Romanian National Federation has implemented a point-scoring method to determine rankings for the 2024 WTCH Qualifications. The point allocation for each position in a competition is as follows:

| - 1st Place: 25 points | - 5th Place: 10 points |
| - 2nd Place: 20 points | - 6th Place: 8 points |
| - 3rd Place: 18 points | - 7th Place: 6 points |
| - 4th Place: 15 points | - 8th Place: 4 points |

Each athlete starts with 0 points at the first event on the 13th of April and can only participate in a maximum of two categories per event.

At the end of the qualifying period, the participant with the highest total points will achieve the top ranking. This system is designed to recognize the most successful and consistent performers across the qualification process, ensuring that they earn the privilege to represent Romania at the World Championships.

ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATION DETAILS:

- Participants are allowed to compete in different categories across the two tournaments, offering flexibility and multiple avenues for athletes to showcase their skills and earn points.
- The best performers across the categories will have the privilege to select the categories they wish to compete in at the World Teqball Championships 2024. This selection process is determined by the total points accumulated during the qualification period.
- The qualification system is designed to accommodate more than four participants, if necessary, based on the final nominations or pairings among the highest-ranking players. This ensures that the most competitive and prepared athletes represent Romania.
- It is possible for example that a player qualifies for the World Championships through participation in only Men's Singles and Mixed Doubles categories and then chooses to compete in Men's Doubles at the World Championships, even if they have not played in the Men's Doubles category during the qualification phase. This flexibility allows for strategic team formations and maximizes Romania's chances of success at the international level.

The qualification system is structured to promote excellence, consistency, and strategic participation across various categories, ensuring that Romania is represented by the most capable athletes at the World Teqball Championships 2024.
