By bringing together the most talented young athletes from FITEQ-affiliated nations, the *European Youth Teqball Championships* aim to strengthen the foundations of the sport through fair competition, international collaboration, and sporting excellence. Pécs, with its historic legacy and expanding sports infrastructure, provides an ideal environment to host this prestigious occasion and welcome the next generation of Teqball professionals.

Key Dates

To ensure the efficient coordination and timely administration of the *European Youth Teqball Championships*, all participating national federations are kindly requested to adhere to the following deadlines:

- 13 July 2025 – Registration by number and category
- 20 July 2025 – Registration by name and category

These deadlines are essential for enabling structured competition planning, fair seeding procedures, and the delivery of a seamless tournament experience for all delegations.

Competition Format and Categories

Each participating nation will be permitted to nominate one (1) athlete or pair per competition category. The 2025 *European Youth Teqball Championships* will feature the following official categories:

- Men's Singles
- Women's Singles
- Men's Doubles
- Women's Doubles
- Mixed Doubles

The competition will be conducted in accordance with FITEQ's official rules and regulations. Further details regarding the match format, draw procedure, and event schedule will be communicated following the conclusion of the registration process.

Age Eligibility

As this is an Under-19 (U19) event, all athletes must be born in 2006 or later in order to be eligible to compete. This age requirement is aligned with FITEQ's strategic objectives to prioritise youth development, talent identification, and the nurturing of future elite players within the sport.
