

The station which is only a 10min walk from the venue is called "Wandsbeker Markt"


The U1 (subway, blue line) is going there. You can use Google Maps or the hvv App for orientation. The hvv App is also useful to buy tickets on an easy way.

Other events/attractions on this weekend

On Friday evening the famous "Hamburger Dom" will open (until 7th December). It's a funfair with a lot of good food and attractions like rollercoasters and things like this. On the weekend it can get really crowded but it has a good atmosphere. It's located on the Heiligengeistfeld next to the St. Pauli stadium.

Also next to the Heiligensgeistfeld is the famous St. Pauli *Bunker*. It was built during the second world war to protect people of St. Pauli. Today, you can walk up there for free and you will have an amazing 360° view.

The *Elbphilharmonie* is located at the Elbe river. You can visit its so-called *Plaza* for free and you will have a nice view on the harbour. You can't visit the inside concert/opera hall, but it is still very worthy to go there. From there you can walk to the *Landungsbrücken*, eat a *Fischbrötchen* and visit the *Elbtunnel* which is tunnel under the Elbe river. You will end up on the other side of the river and will see the Hamburg skyline.

For partying/dancing you can visit the *Reeperbahn*. It's a street with a lot of entertainment and a redlight-district area. If you prefer a calmer atmosphere, but still want to have a drink, visit the area *Sternschanze* or *St. Pauli* and just let the colorful streets lead you.
